



AUTOMATIC HOLSTERS FOR "EUREKA 4" PISTOL

The automatic holster EUREKA4 for pistols is the revolution in the world of police. Once and for all they solve all the worries the police force has in relation to the fire weapon we carry during our service.

The main worries of the police officers are:

- My gun is stolen or I drop it.
- Cartridge in the chamber.
- Training draw technique.

With the automatic holsters EUREKA 4, we carry the weapon totally safe, since it provides two different and totally independent retention systems and it is practically inaccessible to any other that the gun carrier, which helps us feel confident in any situation. To have my gun stolen or taken stops being the officer's biggest worry.

The retention systems within the holster are designed so that the weapon can only be taken out of it when the carrier executes the drawing manoeuvre. These active and passive systems of the EUREKA 4 holsters are designed to avoid the gun from falling out.

The dilemma of whether there is a cartridge in the chamber or not is finally resolved, with its advantages and disadvantages, if we own a EUREKA 4 holster, as just in one move the gun is drawn, the retentions systems are activated and the weapon comes out of the holster loaded in perfectly brandished in a very short time, even disconnecting the manual safety systems of the gun (if they were to be active).

Specific technical training of the various movements, with the corresponding hand and finger positions for the correct manual deactivation of the safety catches of the holster is completely unnecessary with the EUREKA 4 holster, as this mechanisms are deactivated automatically.

What previously required a technical training of various movements it is reduced to just one with the EUREKA 4 holster, allowing us to have the gun ready to be shot incredibly quickly.

The user of the EUREKA 4 holster can take the first shot in less time than using any other holster of similar retention systems and with a cartridge in the chamber.

All actions are done single-handedly.

The time commonly used to load the gun can be dedicated to other techniques.

There will be no more interruptions caused by the slide at the time of loading the gun.

Injuries caused by the weaker hand when loading the gun and the pinches caused by the "ventana de expulsión?"

Loading the weapon is no longer a problem for those with a weak grip.
